We, the undersigned, express our support for the European Code Against Cancer, 5th Edition (ECAC5), recognising it as an essential tool for cancer prevention and health promotion.

In the spirit of cooperation and in pursuit of public health benefits, we commit to:

- Promoting ECAC5 within our networks, communication channels, and activities, tailored to diverse target audiences;
- Supporting education and awareness-raising initiatives that communicate the robust scientific evidence underpinning ECAC5, working to challenge and correct misinformation whenever it emerges;
- Contributing towards innovative and locally adapted approaches, where feasible and appropriate, to encourage the uptake of ECAC5 recommendations;
- Using ECAC5 to foster cross-sectoral and multidisciplinary collaboration with relevant stakeholders for shared public health gains.

This declaration reflects the signatories' independent commitment to support the dissemination of ECAC5 in alignment with public health objectives and the goals of Europe's Beating Cancer Plan. The signatories encourage all other interested organisations to join in this effort.


